General Hazards

The most common workplace hazards consist of trips, falls and slips. Accidents like these happen as a result of the employee losing their balance and stumbling over an item that has not been correctly put away. Placing or removing stuff from storage can lead to a slip or fumble, possibly leading to both worker and item to fall. The potential for trips, falls and slips is increased when staff are moving supplies on different kinds of floor surfaces and on different levels. Another common hazard is getting hit by falling objects. This is usually caused by failure to correctly stack stuff on shelves and other surfaces. Back injuries because of improper lifting techniques are another common danger.

There are inherent risks in using and working around workplace machines. Accidents could often be caused from the incorrect use of forklift trucks, conveyors and hand trucks. Warehouse tools, such as skids, pallets, cutting and strapping tools, must be used cautiously throughout packing, unpacking and loading.

Materials that are dangerous, flammable or combustible present one more kind of workplace hazard while being stored in a warehouse. Workers must know how to take steps to protect themselves from health hazards while working around hazardous materials.
